



M102 Circular Mitts

Finished Size: to fit average Adult

Skill Level: Intermediate

What Our Kit Includes:

- 2-50gram balls of Sheared Beaver Standard Grade Yarn
- 1-50gram ball of Cotton Slub
- 2-10" pieces of 1/4" flat elastic
- 1-Glover's needle

What You Need to Provide:

- Set of four 5 mm (8US) double pointed needles
- Small stitch holder
- Marker (m)
- Large yarn needle
- Sewing thread to match fur

Knitter's Note: Make 2 identical mittens



Method

Cable Cast On 24 sts using fur yarn (see reverse for instructions), dividing sts evenly bet three needles.

Rnd 1- cotton, join work, being careful not to twist sts. Pm, K to end of rnd.

Rnd 2- fur, K.

Rep rnds 1-2 until work measures 5"-5 1/2" (length to desired thumb placement) ending on a cotton rnd.

Next rnd- Slip the next 3 sts onto stitch holder to be worked as thumb later. K.

Next rnd- fur, cast on 3 sts and K to end of rnd.

Next rnd- cotton, K to end of round.

Rep last two rnds until work measures 4" from thumb gusset, ending on a cotton rnd.

Shaping Mitt

Rnd 1- fur, *K 4 sts, K2tog; rep from * to end of rnd (21sts).

Rnd 2- cotton, K to end of round.

Rnd 3- fur, *K 3, K2tog* repeat to end of round (16sts).

Rnd 4-cotton, K to end of round.

Rnd 5- fur, *K2, K2tog, rep from * to end of rnd (12sts).

Cast Off Rnd- fur, divide the sts onto 2 needles and cast off using 3-needle bind off.

Thumb:

Rnd 1- fur, pick up and knit 7 sts along open gusset edge and knit across 3 sts from holder (10sts). Pm and join in the rnd.

Rnd 2- cotton, K.

Rnd 3- fur, K.

Repeat Rnds 2-3 until thumb measures 2 1/2" or desired length, ending on a cotton round.

Cast Off Row- divide the sts onto 2 needles and cast off using the 3-needle bind off.

Finishing: Using Glover's needle and sewing thread sew down cast on and bind off fur ends by sewing to fur of a nearby st. Carefully weave flat elastic through cast-on stitches. Tie together and trim. This will be the bottom edge. Weave in cotton ends.

Machine wash on delicate or hand wash in tepid water. Do not use harsh detergents or soaps (a tsp. of vinegar can be added to water to clean finished item). Lay flat to dry, out of direct sunlight until almost dry. Place in air-only dryer for the remainder of the drying time to fluff the fur. If necessary, to further fluff the fur, brush gently with a dog grooming brush when dry.
